The Washington School of Ballet offers open adult classes throughout the year. Students may join classes *at any time of the year*-no audition or pre-registration is necessary. We encourage students who are unsure about their level to attend an advanced beginner class and discuss their placement with the instructor.

*Dress Code:* The Washington School of Ballet has no required dress code for adult students. We do encourage students to wear a leotard, tights, and ballet slippers, but students are welcome to wear clothing that is comfortable and allows easy movement. Hair should be pulled back from the face and off of the neck.

*Cost:* \$15.00 per class, or \$13.00 with purchase of class card for ballet classes. Class cards are \$130 and are good for ten classes. Cards expire four months after the date of purchase; unused classes will not carry over to a new card.

All classes are held at the Washington School of Ballet, located at 3515 Wisconsin Avenue, NW. The School is near the Cleveland Park and Tenleytown stops on the Metro Red Line, and several buses serve our location.
